The School

Grace Christian School, founded in 1980 by Anchorage Grace Church, educates students in the context of Christian values, so that they would live godly lives in service to others. Over 540 students make up this kindergarten through twelfth grade college preparatory school. Full time high school enrollment is 162, with 44 currently enrolled in the 12th grade. Today, the school serves students from more than 60 area churches on its 7.7 acre south Anchorage campus.

Accreditation & Membership

Grace is accredited through the Association of Christian Schools International and the Northwest Accreditation Commission. The school is a member of the Alaska Schools Activities Association and competes statewide in athletics, music and academics. Student excellence is recognized through a chapter of the National Honor Society. We are also a member of North American Coalition for Christian Admission Professionals.

Grace Christian School offers the following Advanced Placement courses: Government, US History, English Literature & Composition, English Language & Composition, Calculus AB & BC, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Computer Science Principles, and Computer Science Applications.
