#### The School

Over 550 students make up this kindergarten through twelfth grade college preparatory school. Full time high school enrollment is 165 students, with 42 currently enrolled in 12th grade. Today, the school serves more than 60 area churches on its 7.7 acre South Anchorage campus.
